PRESS BRIEFING: HIGH SEAS, 30X30, ANTARCTIC OCEAN PROTECTION

There have been significant multilateral breakthroughs in environmental and ocean governance in the past couple of years with the agreement of the Kunming Global Biodiversity Framework and its 30x30 target as well as the adoption of a new UN High Seas Treaty. This press briefing will outline the critical importance of these international agreements, including for key stakeholders and for ocean health. It will highlight key actions and opportunities to make progress in achieving 30x30 through swift ratification efforts of the High Seas Treaty and designating marine protected areas in international waters, including within Antarctica's Southern Ocean.

PRESS BRIEFING: DEEP SEA MINING, DEEP SEA FISHING AND SEAMOUNT PROTECTION

The deep sea is the largest biome on Earth. It makes up 90% of the marine environment and plays a vital role in regulating our planetary systems, not least by absorbing and storing vast quantities of carbon dioxide emitted by human activities and by supporting an abundance of biodiversity, with new species being discovered nearly every expedition to the deep. Yet, fragile deep-sea ecosystems face numerous stressors, including pollution, climate change and destructive extractive activities. This press briefing will outline the critical need to safeguard and protect the deep sea, focusing on two pressing issues:

- The growing resistance for a deep-sea mining moratorium as discussions continue at the International Seabed Authority
- The need to safeguard seamounts as biodiversity hotspots by ensuring bottom trawling is halted on all seamounts by 2026
